

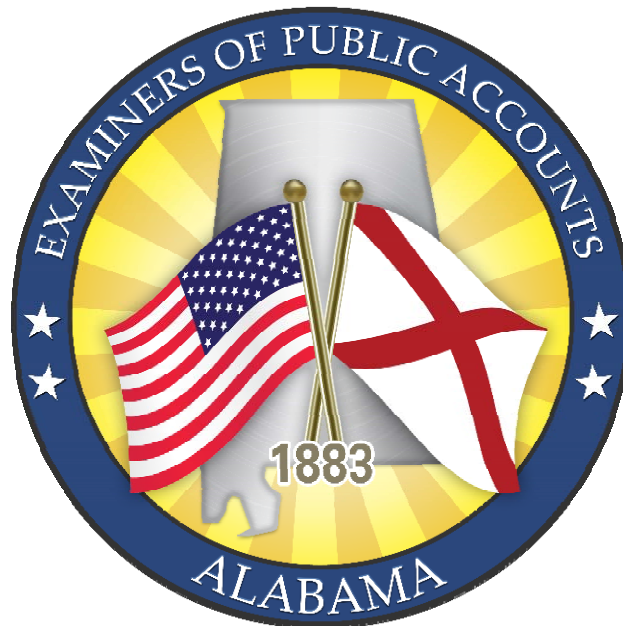

SUMMARY

**Judicial Administration Fund
Talladega County, Alabama
August 1, 2015 through September 30, 2018**

The Judicial Administration Fund, Talladega County, Alabama, (herein referred to as the “Judicial Administration Fund”) was established under the authority of Act Number 96-313, Acts of Alabama, which adds a one-dollar court charge to all circuit and district court cases except small claims cases. The Presiding Circuit Judge supervises the fund and must authorize the disbursement of any funds. The proceeds are to be expended for the purpose of increasing the efficiency of judicial administration in Talladega County, including, but not limited to, training and enhancement of judicial personnel in Talladega County. The Judicial Administration Fund receipts, disburses and otherwise accounts for fees taxed as costs in court cases and miscellaneous receipts.

Honorable Julian M. King served as Presiding Circuit Judge during the examination period.

This report presents the results of an examination of the Judicial Administration Fund and a review of compliance by the Judicial Administration Fund with applicable laws and regulations of the State of Alabama in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts under the authority of the *Code of Alabama 1975*, Section 41-5A-12, as added by Act Number 2018-129.

Tests performed during the examination did not disclose any significant instances of noncompliance with applicable state or local laws and regulations.

The Official was invited to discuss the results of the examination at an exit conference held at the Presiding Circuit Judge’s Office. Representing the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts was Jimmy Flowers, Examiner of Public Accounts.
