**SUMMARY**

**Law Library Fund  
Bibb County, Alabama  
September 1, 2016 through May 31, 2019**

The Law Library Fund was created pursuant to the *Code of Alabama 1975*, Sections 11-25-1 through 11-25-13, for the sole purpose of establishing, maintaining and operating a law library in Bibb County. The creating legislation provides for the presiding circuit judge of the county to administer the Law Library Fund and to appoint an advisory committee for the county law library. The advisory committee consists of local attorneys with no term limitations and the District Judge.

Honorable Marvin Wiggins served as Presiding Circuit Judge from the beginning of the examination period through May 17, 2019. Honorable Collins Pettaway served as interim Presiding Circuit Judge from May 18, 2019, through the end of the examination period.

This report presents the results of an examination of the Law Library Fund and a review of compliance by the Law Library Fund with applicable laws and regulations of the State of Alabama in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts under the authority of the *Code of Alabama 1975*, Section 41-5A-12, as added by Act Number 2018-129.

Tests performed during the examination did not disclose any significant instances of noncompliance with applicable state or local laws and regulations.

The Officials were invited to discuss the results of this report at an exit conference. An exit conference was held via phone with Honorable Marvin Wiggins, Presiding Circuit Judge, by a representative of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts: Brooke P. Warren, Examiner.
