



**SUMMARY**

**Law Library, Judicial Technology and Judicial Administration Fund  
Marshall County, Alabama  
August 1, 2016 through May 31, 2019**

The Law Library, Judicial Technology and Judicial Administration Fund operates under the provisions of Act Number 2008-505, Acts of Alabama. The receipts of this fund consist primarily of fees taxed on all cases filed in the District and Circuit Courts of the county. The fund is maintained by the County Commission which disburses the funds at the request of the Presiding Circuit Judge.

Honorable Tim Jolley served as Presiding Circuit Judge from the beginning of the examination period until January 13, 2017. Honorable Tim Riley served as Presiding Circuit Judge from January 14, 2017 through the end of the examination period.

This report presents the results of an examination of the Law Library, Judicial Technology and Judicial Administration Fund and a review of compliance with applicable laws and regulations of the State of Alabama in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts under the authority of the *Code of Alabama 1975*, Section 41-5A-12, as added by Act Number 2018-129.

Tests performed during the examination did not disclose any significant instances of noncompliance with applicable state or local laws and regulations.

The Officials were invited to and attended an exit conference to discuss the results of this report. Representing the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts was: Joseph White, Examiner of Public Accounts.
